The rains came in the afternoon and qualifying was canceled.

The teams would line up for the Menard's 200 on Sunday based on owners points. McCurley started the event in 12th position. The car started out a little loose, and the team made adjustments during pit stops, with the car responding well to those adjustments. Short track racing was true to its exciting form for the packed grandstands, and McCurley was definitely adding to that excitement with the #03.

With 6 laps to go, McCurley saw an opening to pass for 8th position. He went for it, and with side by side Toledo racing the pass became too tight of a squeeze - McCurley backed off and was tagged from behind. He spun, but did not hit anything. The yellow came out, and the #03 got going again and back into position – staying on the lead lap. The final green, white, checker brought McCurley in for an 11th place finish.

“The team did a fantastic job today,” says team owner Donny Kelley. “ We are getting good consistent finishes, great pit stops, and Stephan’s doing a great job driving. The car was just getting better and better, we just ran out of laps. We had a top five car today.”

The PGM team also gave out over 500 complimentary t-shirts and hats to the Toledo race fans during the meet and greet before the race. Each race, the team gives out the apparel to the fans, and for any new sponsors that come on board with the team.
